



NEW BEGINNINGS ORPHANAGES INTERNATIONAL

Narrative Budget

We provide resources to help orphans heal mentally, physically, and spiritually. Our resources include the provision of medical and dental care, psychological and trauma recovery counseling, and exposure to the Bible, coupled with loving examples of its applications.

We Rescue and House

We work with children who have been abused and abandoned in a variety of situations. Many of the children have suffered from physical or sexual abuse that has left them to fend for themselves in harsh situations.

Operation Educate-Kaberi

Through Jamii Int. Outreach Ministry School, we provide buildings, clean water, book supplies, school uniforms, two meals a day for 200 kids, and teacher salaries in the Kibera Slum.

Cost-\$1,121/per child/ per yr. for 250 children

Kibera School Project

Expansion is now occupied with over 200 children. Repairs for the roof and renovations for fire damages is the current project.

Cost- \$55,715

Life on Life

Life on Life helps those who age out at 18 and desire to learn to make disciples. We help them through this transition initiative for three years to establish a Biblical worldview that honors God. Resources are expended on the cost of housing and utilities and nutritional support.

Cost- \$250/mo. for 60 people

Orphan Higher Ed

The Orphan Higher Education initiative assists in continuing education for orphans interested in pursuing higher education beyond high school, leading to future employment and business opportunities.

Cost-\$10,000/yr. per student for seven students

Business as Ministry

The Business as Ministry initiative focuses on sustainability for former orphans who want to start small businesses. The entrepreneur endeavor gives them the opportunity to become self-sustaining givers. Sound business proposals are evaluated and presented to potential donors who have interest in supporting the vision of business as a ministry.

Cost-\$50,000/yr to start and sustain 6 businesses

Orphan Care-Jamii Nakuru

The Orphan Care Ministry teams are trusting God to provide clean, safe drinking water and farming sustainability projects. The resources earned will be given to children still facing homelessness back in the Villages some of them came out of.

Cost- \$100/mo. per child for 50 children

NBOI-USA

Through a variety of partnerships, we provide programming services to foster care youth focused on character development, educational attainment, and career exploration.

Starting a mentoring home for foster kids, children with absentee parents, and youth with adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) is the long-term goal.

Cost-\$75,000 to launch

Mission Travel

NBOI-Africa and NBOI-USA staff travel once per year to assess previous ministry programs and services and plan for the upcoming year.

Cost-\$5,025/person

Administration and Overhead

Including salaries, transportation and travel, and administration overhead.

Cost-\$300,000

Special Events

Including banquets and local events.

Cost-\$18,000

Total=\$1,104,040
