## TARGET AUDIENCE

- Young women in foster care (eventually young men)
- Youth with Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)
- 7th to 12th grade or appropriate age
- Open to all races, with a strong focus on underserved communities including Black and Latino young women

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## PROGRAM GOALS

- Educational Attainment
  - Improve school attendance and academic performance
- Career Exploration
  - Improve skill sets and job readiness
- Character Development
  - Assist with social-emotional and behavioral disorders and treatment plans

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## PROGRAMMATIC ACTIVITIES

- Secure funding via donors, grants, etc.
- Build a team of vetted volunteers (background checks)
- Build a collaborative network of stakeholders and collaborators
- Build a calendar
- Build a curriculum

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## EVIDENCED-BASED, TRAUMA INFORMED MENTORING

- Our approach to services is grounded in research specific to youth in foster care and with adverse childhood experiences
- Theoretical frameworks: 1) Attachment Theory 2) Social Support Theory 3) Resiliency Theory
